Alongside Mahahathi, other individuals such as Khadahari Hathi, Sivakhada Hathi and Pahalamasi were known from their coins. They are all very rare. The Hathi Maharathis, pertinently for their name, struck coins in the elephant type.

These types of coins are very different from other issues of Yadavas and was perhaps struck at a diffident provincial mint. The Vaishnavite context of most symbols makes it clear that the coin is an issue of Yadavas.

Complete legend with outer margin, *extremely fine+, rare in this grade.*

These coin series merge into the issues of the Arakan Rajas and may therefore have been struck at a more southerly mint, eg. Ramu. Mitchiner attributes the smaller flan coin to Chittagong and the larger flan to Ramu.

- 45 **Shams al din Muzaffar Shah III - Second Reign, Silver Rupee, 10.69g, Dar al Darb Ahmedabad Mint, AH 992, Obv: "*sultan muzaffar shah ibn Mahmud shah*" within double square with dots in between, marginal legend probably, "*al sultan al a'zam khallada allah mulkahu wa sultanahu*" and mint name, Rev: Shahada within double square with dots in between four caliphs in the margin (G&G# G647). Very fine, extremely rare.**

In 1583/ AH 991 Muzaffar Shah III regain the throne of Gujarat for very short span. He struck coins in Mughal pattern in his second reign. Coins dated 991 are rare but coins dated 992 are extremely rare. Muzaffar shah was later captured by Mughal army, he made suicide near Dhamdka- Kutch.
