

The region of Tripuri emerged as a localized polity with its own set of local rulers in post-Mauryan times. So far, only the rulers with '-Mitra' and '-Datta' ending names were known; these were first brought to notice by late RR Bhargava of Jabalpur in a series of articles. This is the first instance of a ruler with a '-Gupta' ending name being known and as such adds an important nugget of data to the story of post-Maurvan regional state formation.




