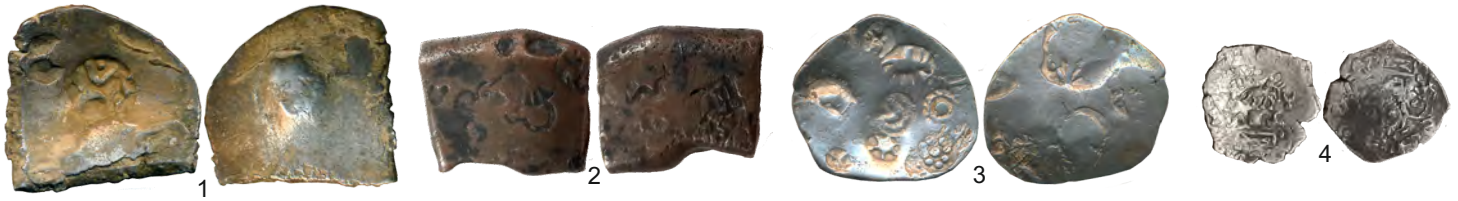

- 16 **Pre-Satavahana, Vidarbha Region, Ashvabudha**, Copper, **Punch Marked**, 3.06g, Paoni area, Uniface, Five symbol type, Tree and four orb Ujjaini symbol on top, Bull and geometric symbol and in centre Brahmi legend "**Asubudh**" on obverse (Kulkarni ICS Newsletter No. 41). *Very fine, very rare.* From Paoni area coins with the ending name "Bhadasa" and "Mitasa" rulers are known but very few specimens are known of ruler Asubudh. *Very rare.*

Very fine for type, extremely rare.*

The region of Tripuri emerged as a localized polity with its own set of local rulers in post-Mauryan times. So far, only the rulers with '-Mitra' and '-Datta' ending names were known; these were first brought to notice by late R R Bhargava of Jabalpur in a series of articles. This is the first instance of a ruler with a '-Gupta' ending name being known and as such adds an important nugget of data to the story of post-Mauryan regional state formation.

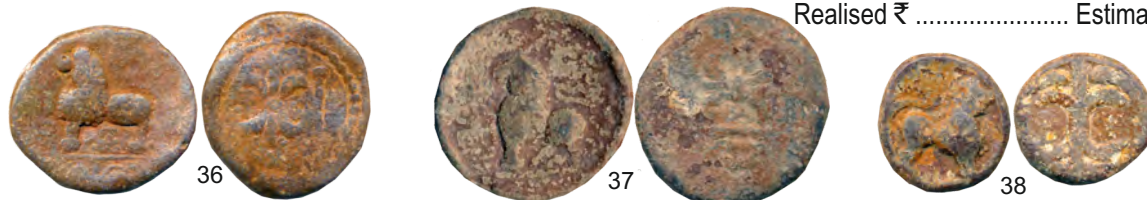

The issues of Nahapana as a Kshatrpa from Junnar are conspicuous by the absence of 'bow-and-arrow' symbol on the reverse, and are much rarer than the 'Mahakshatrpa' issues which incorporate this symbol.
