The coin has an unusually detailed and artistic symbolic program. The depiction of a facing elephant is also highly unusual for a Deccan series of uninscribed coins.

A wavy line representing a river to the left (Unpublished in major sources). *Very fine, very rare.*

The legend on this coin is not very clear and it is likely to be Sirimata overstruck on a coin of Maharathi Talantathi.

These coins were attributed with Bhaskaravarman, the king of Kamarupa, based on his title Kumara". Coins of Sri Kumara have been discovered from Assam (Paglatek Hoard) and Agartala/Tripura (Brahmakunda Hoard) district so it was assumed that Bhaskarvarman might have extended his reign up to Samatata region. However, 'Kumara' appears to be a common name for the contemporary period and thus may also be a local ruler of Samatata region as well.
