

Ancient Deccan, South- East Maharashtra region, Uninscribed Biface Taurine Shape Cast Copper, 9.54g, Obv: Triangle headed standard and a box-like symbol in the upper section; Shrivatsa in the lower section, Rev: Triangle headed standard in the upper section, Nandipada in the lower section (Unpublished in major sources). *Extremely fine, extremely rare.*

The tradition of casting coins in different shapes has been known from certain regions in the North – there is a series of coins of 'Damaru', diamond, semi-circle etc shapes known from Kaushambi. However intentionally fashioning coins in a shape that was of a reverential symbol appears to have been a practice confined to the West and the South. This coin is of an extremely rare type, which is shaped like the holy symbol of Nandipada or taurine. The symbol, originally perhaps of a bovine significance was later taken up by the Buddhists to denote the 'three jewels' – Buddha, Dharma and Sangha – of their faith. There is hardly any comparison to this unique shape in the broad range of early uninscribed cast copper coins.


Ancient Deccan, Biface Uninscribed Cast Copper, Heavy Unit, 9.71g, Obv: Three-arched hill surmounted by crescent, Rev: Open cross symbol. *Patinated, extremely fine.*These coins were attributed to Taxila due to the fact that similar coins had been found in the excavations. However, in recent years

after the contributions of K K Maheshwari who collected them mainly in Hyderabad, their identity as post- Mauryan early uninscribed cast copper series has been established more firmly.



City state Bhagila, Vidisha region, Punch Marked, Inscribed Copper, 3.91g, Uniface, Four punches – 1. Bull walking to right, 2. Tree in-railing, 3. Wavy line (river) with fishes and turtles, 4. Brahmi legend "Bhagilaya" on obverse (Pieper# 495). Very fine, extremely rare.

City state Kurara, Ancient Eastern Malwa, Vidisha region, Die-struck Copper, 10.46g, Obv: Brahmi legend "Kuraraya" between three arched hill above and open cross symbol below, Rev: Open cross symbol with Swastika in the centre. *Uncleaned, very fine, rare.*

The city state of Kurara most probably was located near the present day town of Kurwai on the river Betwa. During the post-Mauryan times it issued an extensive coinage. The earliest of these coins, like this one, do not show any dynastic affiliation and were purely city-state issues. Later issues adopt symbolism to suggest that the city had aligned itself first with the local rulers of Vidisha and then with the Satavahanas.

City state, Suktimati, Vatsa / Chedi Region, Inscribed Cast Copper, 1.94g, Obv: Bull walking to left, traces of a tree to left; Brahmi legend "Sutimati" above, Rev: Elephant walking to left triangle-headed standard to left and Ujjain symbol above. Very fine, very rare. Ancient Indian texts mention that the capital city of Chedi, a kingdom which fell roughly in the Bundelkhand division of Madhya Pradesh regions to the south of river Yamuna along the river Ken, was called Suktimati in Sanskrit and Sotthivati-nagara in Pali. In the Mahabharata, Dhrishtaketu was the name of the king of Chedi who sided with the Kauravas.

These coins are usually described as 'Vijayaka'; however, the legend is clearly 'Vejayike' and might refer to an as yet undetermined city-state located somewhere in the Ujjain region.

Malwa - Ujjain region, "Brahma", Inscribed die-struck Copper, 2.94g, Obv: figure of standing man, holding bent renunciator's staff and water pot, 'Ujjain'-symbol to top left; Brahmi legend "Bramha" in top right corner, Rev: Sixarched hill topped by a Chhatra, traces of "Brahmi" legend below (Pieper# 410-411). Very fine, extremely rare.

Pieper describes the legend below the hill-symbol as 'Dhavata' but it is in all likelihood 'Pavata' (Parvata = hill/ mountain). It is not yet clear whether the legend 'Brahma' refers to the figure or it is the name of an issuing authority. The coin-type is enigmatic, very rare and significant for the study of ancient Indian polity and religion.

Very fine, rare.

51 Erikarcha, Ancient Betwa Valley, Dasharna region- Monarchical Coinage, Amatya Ashadhamitra, Copper, 3.61g, Obv: Brahmi legend "Amatya Ashadhamitra..." above two stylized inverted Nandipada symbols, Rev: arched hill and a tree-in-railing symbols. Very fine, very rare.

The area around Erichh on the river Betwa was ruled by rulers with non-regal titles for a while, following the collapse of the Sunga kingdom. From inscriptions and coins, rulers with titles Amatya and Mahasenapati are known, which eventually give way to rulers with the full 'Raja' title. Even if the rulers held lesser titles, it does not mean that they were not independent rulers in their own right. Ashadhamitra is also known from a brick inscription found at Musanagar near Erichh. This is the only known instance of an individual holding a ministerial title having struck his own coins. Sold `..... Estimate: ` 5,000-6,000

Ahsanabad was the Islamic alias of the city of Gulbarga, which was renamed by the Bahmani ruler Ala al-Din Hasan Bahman Shah after himself. The name had fallen in disuse after the Bahmani Sultanate ended. It was revived again by Aurangzeb towards the end of his reign. Minting at Ahsanabad had become very sporadic in early 18th century with gold issues being virtually unknown. This is the first gold coin known of the period. Although it bears the normal 'Badshah Bahr wa Bar' couplet of Farrukhsiyar, his name is written by joining 'Kh' and 'S' together. This feature is seen only on coins of couple of other mints, like Firozgarh.




